Our days include structured activities that expand children's horizons and abilities. It also allows some time for free play, independent exploration and making friends. Led by highly qualified, early childhood education trained staff. The air-conditioned preschool classrooms along with our fenced in playground equipped with sprinklers provide a fun environment. Weekly themes, arts and crafts, special events, and instructional swim (does not include Starfish) are all part of the camp experience. We also have Super Soccer Stars for Dolphins, Sharks and the Creative Adventure Group.

Must enroll for at least two sessions. \$250 non-refundable deposit is required to register in addition to \$60 child membership fee. Closed July 4th.

Starfish (Children must be 3 by December 31, 2012) Specially designed for children who have attended pre-school. Campers benefit from highly individualized attention and low camper-to-staff ratio. Outdoor sprinkler time and water play every day (weather permitting). Children bring lunch. Snack is included.

Children must be fully toilet trained. Snack is included.
